Dear Mr. Warren,

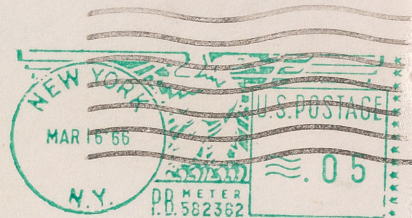
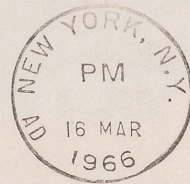
